SHE IS PERFORMER ALI STROKER



Ali Stroker was a groundbreaking performer when she became the first actress in a wheelchair to appear on a Broadway stage, as Anna in the 2015 revival of “Spring Awakening”. Then, in 2019 she became the first actress in a wheelchair to win a Tony Award for her role as Ado Annie in “Oklahoma”. As a humanitarian and advocate she is a co-chair of Women Who Care, which supports United Cerebral Palsy of New York City.

She is also a founding member of the anti-bullying campaign “Be More Heroic”.

Ali’s inspiring work is reflected in her motto: “Making Your Limitations Your Opportunities”.
